



Fire Safety Regulations

Anyone noticing a fire should

- report this immediately to the security service at the reception
- or use the nearest alarm box in the corridor.

The Fire Department's emergency toll-free number in Hungary is:

In the case of a fire emergency call, the following information must be given:

- the exact location of the fire
- what is burning
- who and what is in danger
- are people injured or dead
- the name of the person who is reporting the fire.

All students, employees and visitors should fully acquaint themselves with actions to be taken in case of fire, bomb alerts or other emergencies. A training session on fire safety is obligatory for every student and employee each Academic Year. Fire drills are organized in order to ensure that evacuation procedures can be carried out smoothly in case of emergency.

Fire escape routes are marked in each building by international symbols of green/white lights. In case of a fire, everyone should spread the alarm and evacuate the respective building immediately through the nearest emergency exit. The use of elevators is not allowed. The escape routes and doors must not be blocked, even for short periods of time.

Smoke and fire detectors are installed in the building. Fires or areas of smoke will automatically sound the alarms. (Please note that smoking is allowed only in designated smoking areas.)
